



***The Year of Pleasures*


***Fairytale* by Danielle Steel



River Road by Jayne Ann Krentz November 28, 2018




Rebecca by Daphne Du Maurier December 26, 2018


Do or Die by Suzanne Brockman January 30, 2019


Someone to Hold by Suzanne Brockman February 27, 2019


Red Lily by Nora Roberts March 27, 2019
