### Free Music from the Library Website!



Did you know that you can access **FREE** music from the Parker Library website? Not only is it FREE, but you never have to return the songs you download!

**Freegal** is a downloadable and streaming music service from your library. It offers hundreds of thousands of songs, over 100 genres of music, and more than 50 record labels, all without having to download any software.

Library users have a limit of three downloads per week. Your counter will set back to zero each week, Monday morning. Then you can download three more tunes during the new week.

The downloads are all in the MP3 format with no DRM. This service will work with any MP3 player, including iPods, and can be loaded into

iTunes. It works on both PCs and Macs.

You will be able to keep track of your downloads in the upper right corner of the site. Every song has a sample clip you can listen to before you download.

You can also create streaming music playlists that can be played in your desktop browser and *Freegal* Music app.
