COLLECTION, CIRCULATION, AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

The Parker Memorial Library continues to be a center of activity and use. In 2010, the Library had 152,096 visits and circulated 256,820 books, DVDs, magazines, and other resources to the public.

The Parker Memorial Library now offers downloadable e-books and audio books, databases for practice tests on SAT's or professional licensing, business directories, computer e-books, and more. Each of these resources is available 24/7 to all residents of Dracut.

The Friends of the Parker Memorial Library held their Book Sale in May and their Holiday Auction in December. Both fundraising efforts were extremely successful. Thank you to everyone who volunteered their time or attended these events.

In 2010, the Friends of the Parker Memorial Library once again supported the Museum Pass program along with Ms. Penny's children's programming and the annual Summer Reading program. Without the Friends, what the Parker Memorial Library is or could be would be lessened greatly.

While books certainly are part of what a library does, people whether it is the staff, the public, or our volunteers are the core of our library. The Trustees wish to recognize and thank the work and commitment of our volunteers.
