

## Parker Library Home Delivery Service

The Parker Library's home delivery program brings library materials to Dracut patrons up to 2 times a month. Library staff will select books and other material according to the preferences of the user. Trained volunteers retrieve and deliver library materials for patrons who are unable to get to the library.

### Who is eligible for the service?

Dracut residents who are unable to come to the library due to a permanent condition, or a temporary condition that will last four weeks or more. For example, patrons who may no longer be able to drive, have mobility problems, require extended bed rest, or have a broken leg.

### How do I apply?

Fill out the application included in this brochure. It can be mailed or dropped off to the Parker Memorial Library. A library card is needed to use this service. If you do not already have one, please call 978-454-5474 and ask for the Home Delivery Program.



### What can I expect?

Once the application has been approved, a library staff member will contact you. During that phone call, we will establish a delivery schedule and determine how many items (up to 6) you would like to receive in each delivery. You may choose your own items or have a staff member choose them for you based on your preferences.

After the phone call, you will be matched with one of our Home delivery volunteers. Volunteers are dedicated community members who donate time in order to help run the service. All volunteers will complete and pass a CORI check before coming to your home.

## Volunteers Needed

The M.G. Parker Library is always looking for dedicated volunteers to deliver and pick up library materials to the home delivery patrons who are unable to visit the library on their own.

Volunteers are matched up with participants in the program. On average, you will be asked to visit residents twice a month.

To qualify to be a volunteer you must be over the age of 18 and be physically able to deliver library materials. You must possess a valid Massachusetts Driver's License, submit to and pass a CORI (Criminal Offence Record Information) check, and have proof of current auto insurance. You should also be comfortable working with older and/or disabled adults.
